Bruno's empire reached \$500 million in sales in 2011, so it's safe to assume he's a busy man. When he needs to chill out, he checks out this spot on the **Upper East Side** that specializes in both tea and honey.

Since I've become addicted to yoga and cut down on the amount of coffee I drink, I am always on the hunt for tasty and satisfying teas and chais. I recently stumbled on **The Tea & Honey Store**. It is a little jewelbox of a shop across the street from Bloomingdales—blink and you miss it. Inside is like a beehive with honeycomb—like hexagons that house an amazing selection of teas and organic honey. The staff knows their stuff and I always find the most obscure and fascinating items from around the world.

I just sampled the Rishi Orange Blossom Green Tea that is just terrific on ice. Their selection of artisanal honey is just as eclectic, and many come from local apiaries on the East End of Long Island. Right now I can't live without their Tupelo Honey.
