Thursday evening, March 12th, Love Heals, the Alison Gertz Foundation for AIDS Education raised over \$450,000 at its gala event at The Four Seasons Restaurant in Manhattan. All proceeds from the evening directly support Love Heals' efforts to protect the next generation of New Yorkers from HIV.

The program was created in response to an alarming statistic that confirmed a 132% increase in the HIV infection rate among young men who had sex with men between 2001 and 2011. In the coming years Love Heals is committed to reversing this trend as it has done in its work with young women of color.
